

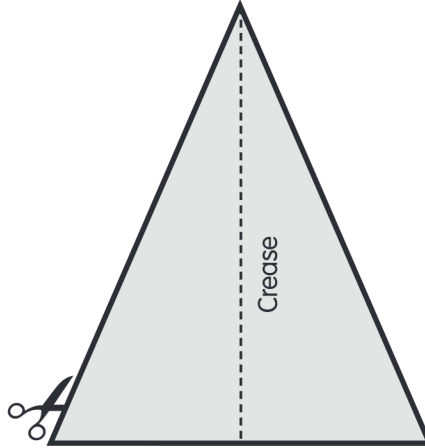
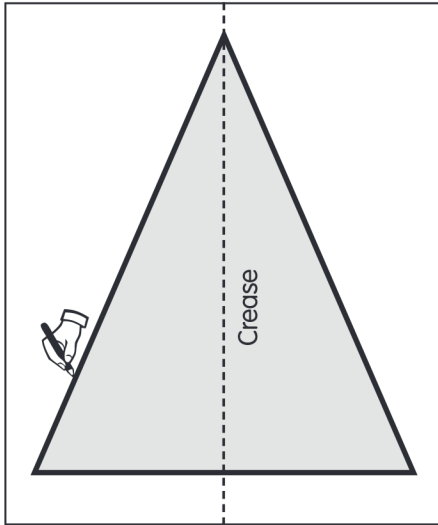

HOW TO CREATE A 3-D WITCH – Geometric Design



You will need:

- Crayola Metallic FX Crayons or Crayola Construction Paper Crayons
- Black Construction Paper - 30.c cm x 45 cm (12" x 18")
- Crayola Washable Glue
- Crayola Glitter Glue
- Scissors
- Photocopy Paper
- Rulers
- Pencils and Erasers
- Large Paper Clips
- Googly Eyes and Other Embellishments

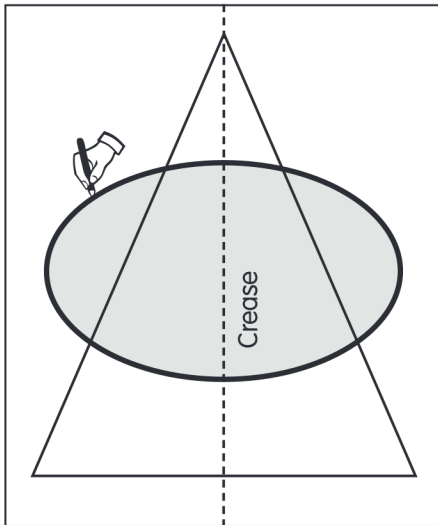


1. TRACERS

- Cut out the geometric shapes to use as tracers.
- Choose the triangle.
- Fold the triangle so the fold goes from the centre of the base of the triangle to the topmost vertex.
- Open the triangle.

2. TEMPLATE

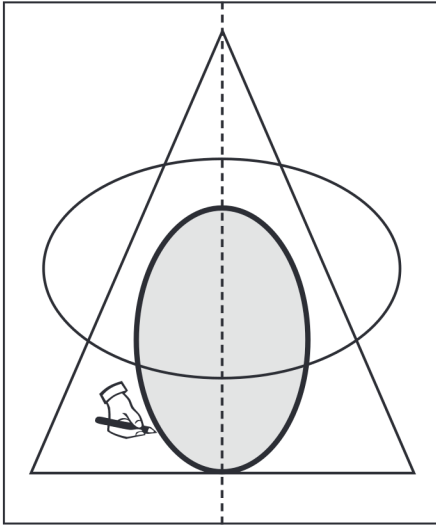
- Fold a piece of copy paper in half long end to long end.
- Open the paper.
- Place the triangle on top of the copy paper so the creases line up.
- Trace the triangle onto the copy paper.

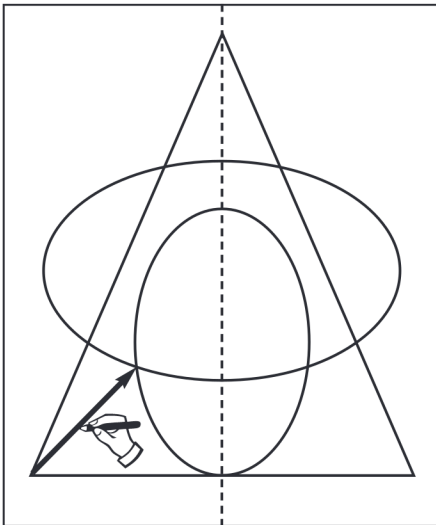
- Fold the large oval in half short end to short end.
- Place it on top of the triangle near the middle.
- Line up the crease on the copy paper with the crease on the triangle – the lines of symmetry.
- Trace the oval.

HOW TO CREATE A 3-D WITCH – TEMPLATE



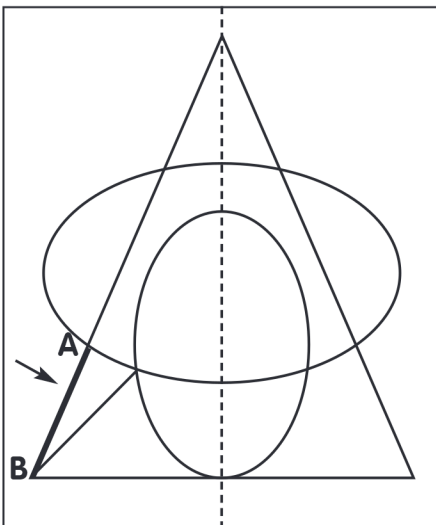

- Fold the small oval in half long end to long end.
- Place it on top of the triangle so the bottom of the oval sits on the base of the triangle
- Line up the crease on the oval with the crease on the triangle.
- Trace the oval.



5.

- Draw a line segment from the vertex at the base of the triangle to the intersection of the ovals.



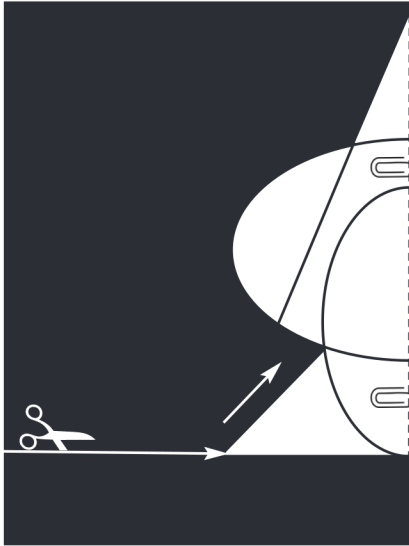
6.

- Erase the line segment **AB**.



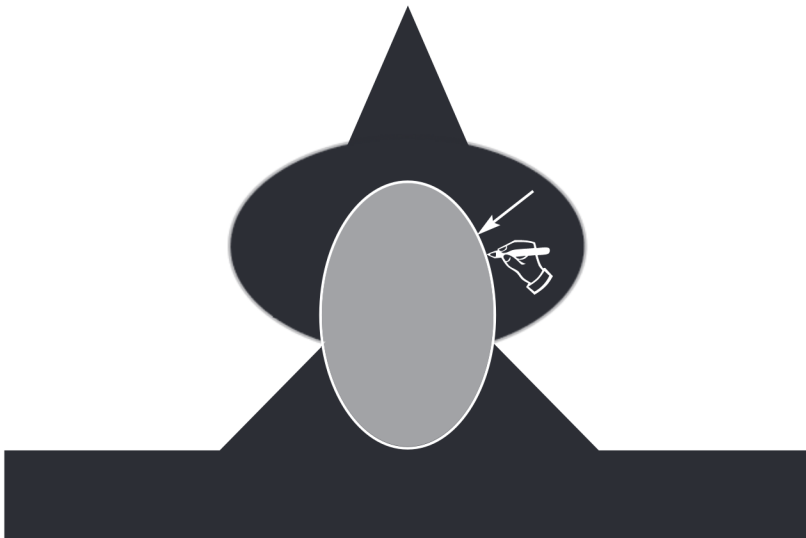
7.

- Fold the paper in half.
- Cut it out around the outer edges to create a symmetrical shape.
- This is your **template**.



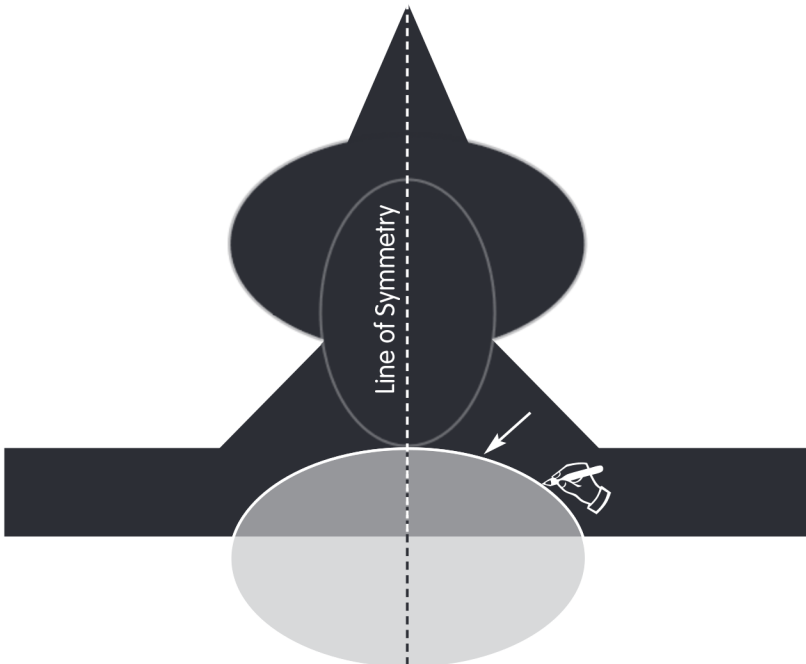
8. WITCH

- Fold a piece of 30.5 cm x 45 cm (12" x 18") black construction paper in half short end to short end.
- Place the folded template along the folded end of the construction paper with the topmost vertex of the triangle at the top of the construction paper.
- Paperclip the template to the paper.
- Draw a horizontal line from the vertex at the base of the triangle to the outer edge of the construction paper.
- Cut along the line and then the outer edge of the template.



9.

- Remove the paperclips
- Open the black construction paper.
- Place the small oval on the construction paper so it matches your template.
- Trace around it.



10.

- Fold the large oval in half short end to short end.
- Open it up.
- Place it on the black paper to form shoulders.
- Line up the centre crease with the line of symmetry.
- Trace around the edge of the large oval.



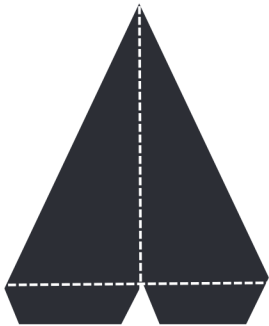
11. HAIR

- Fold the construction paper in half.
- Cut about half way along the lower edge of the symmetrical shape to form the bottom of the hair.
- Cut a few small triangles into the bottom of the shape.

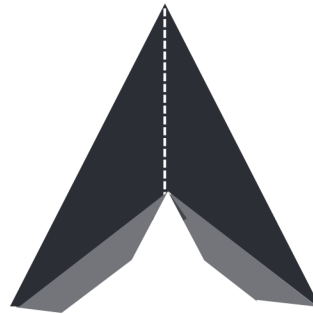


12. NOSE

- Fold a small piece of black construction paper in half.
- Cut out a small triangle.
- Cut a small part off both vertexes on the base of the triangle at about a 45° angle to make tabs.



- Open the triangle.

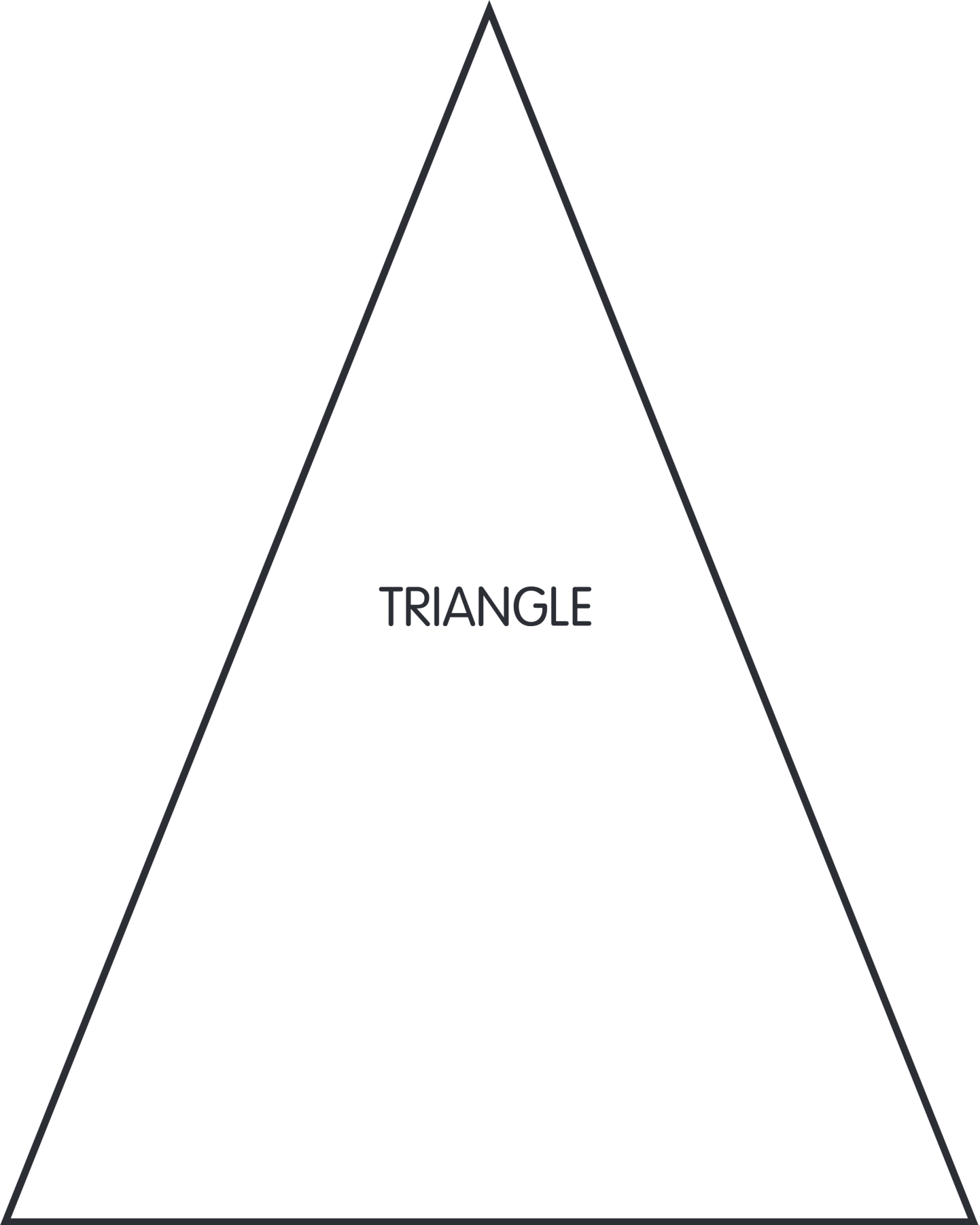


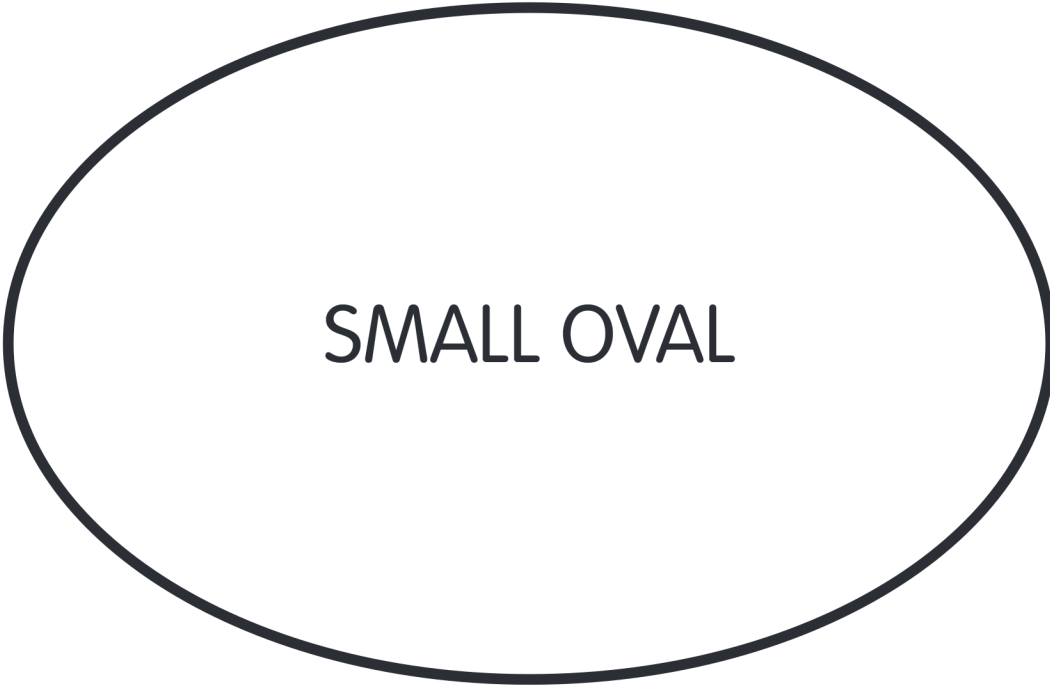
- Fold the tabs at right angles.
- Place the nose on the face at the centre fold to see if you like it and if it is the right size.
- **Colour the nose before you glue it to the face.**



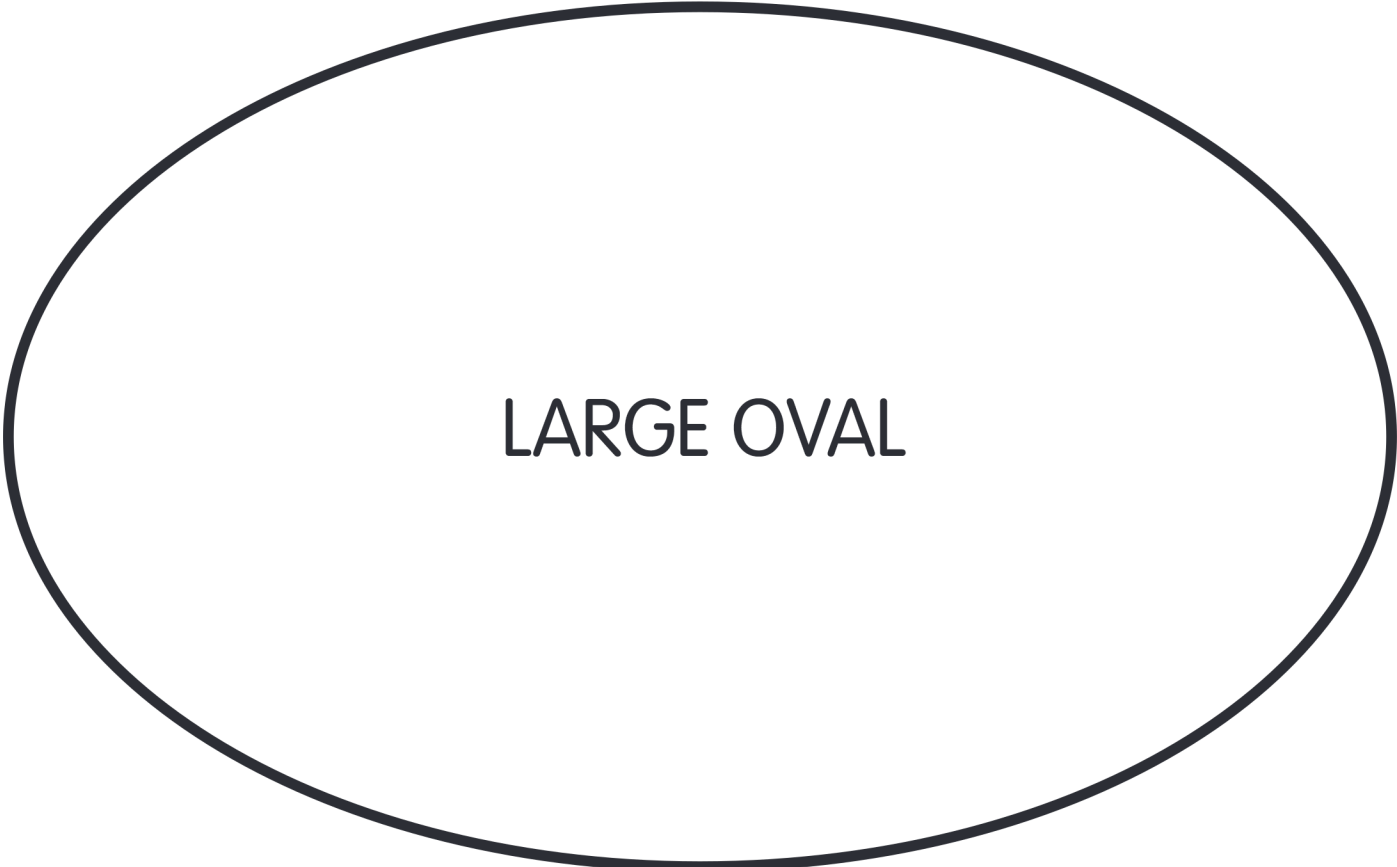
13. COLOUR

- Use Crayola Construction Paper or Metallic FX crayons to colour the witch.
- Add other embellishments to make it unique.
- Use glitter glue to add special effects.
- When the glue is dry fold the strip of construction paper around to the back and staple the ends together to allow your witch to stand.
