Crayola Crew Creative Thinking Sheet



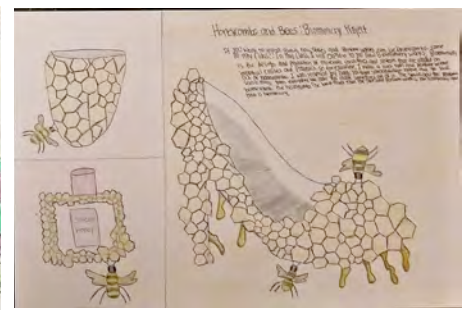
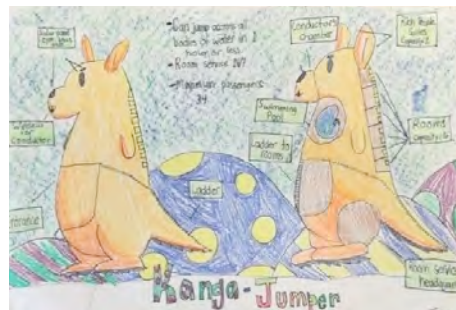
