Crayola Crew Creative Thinking Sheet



RESPOND to the Crayola Crew video in which they are making a movie. Come up with your own movie ideas including a story, script, and costume ideas.



CREATE a three-part storyboard sketch that shows your original movie's beginning, middle, and end. Under each frame, draft dialogue to go with the image. Consider some colourful costumes that could bring your story to life.



SKETCH A SCENE FOR YOUR STORY'S BEGINNING, MIDDLE, AND END, AND WRITE DIALOGUE FOR EACH SCENE.
