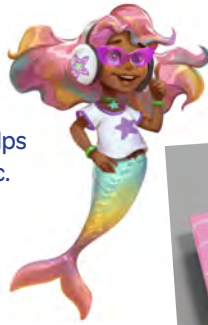
Crayola Crew Creative Thinking Sheet



RESPOND to the video in which the Crayola Crew helps the DJ Mermaid find creative ways to create music.



CREATE music using objects that are on hand such as pots, pans, kitchen utensils, your hands, and your feet. Hum a familiar tune while you make percussive sounds with these objects to emphasize the rhythmic patterns in the song.



SKETCH AND LABEL WHAT COULD MAKE VARIOUS SOUNDS SUCH AS: CLICK, CLAP, TAP, RING, OR POP.

PRESENT your sound patterns to others and ask them to follow your lead as everyone hums another song and adds the sound patterns to the vocals.
