Appreciating Teachers



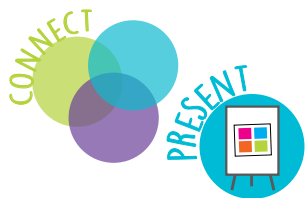
RESPOND to the learning opportunities that are around
