Crayola Crew Creative Thinking Sheet



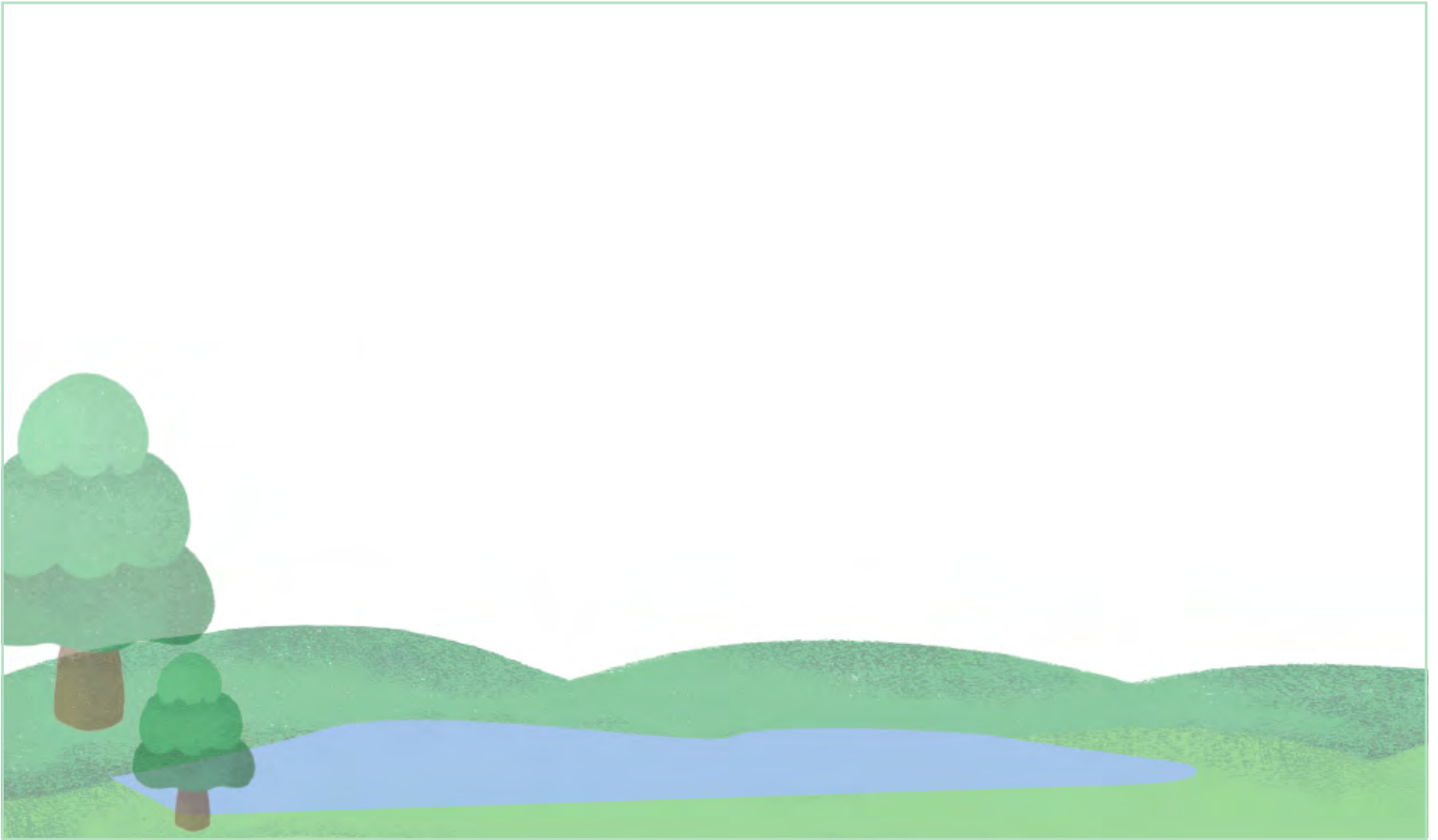
RESPOND to the video in which the Crayola Crew helps a nervous butterfly boost her confidence and learn to fly.
